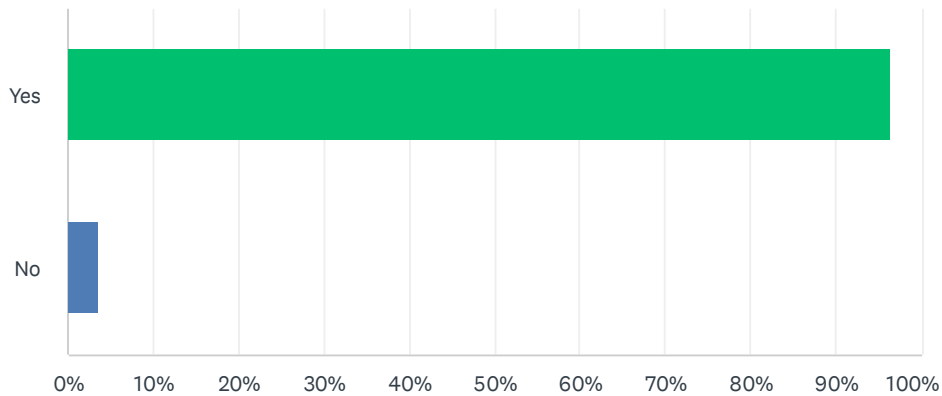


Q1 Are you the AP Coordinator for your school this year?

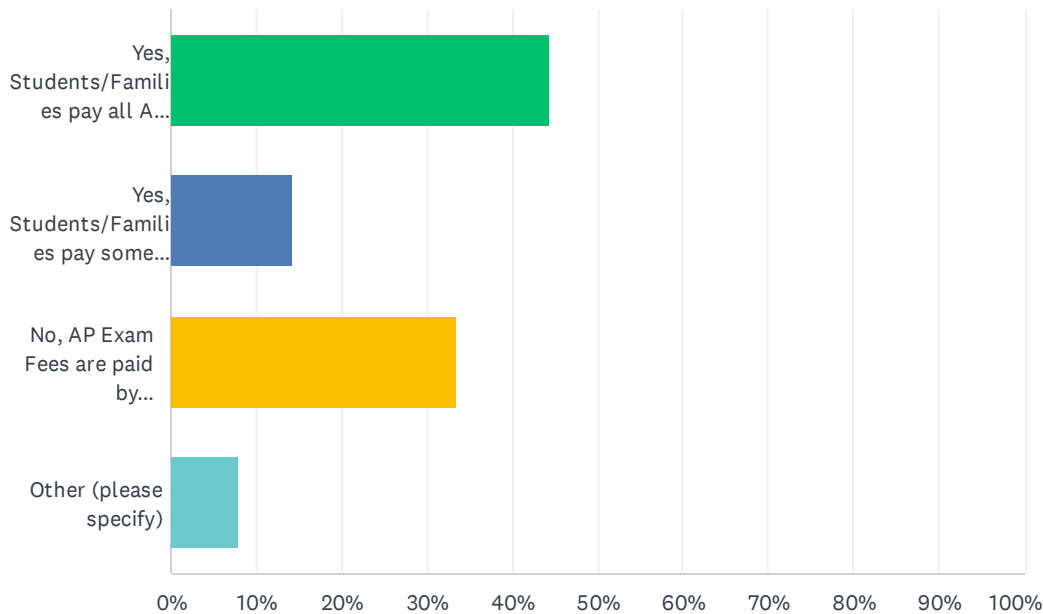

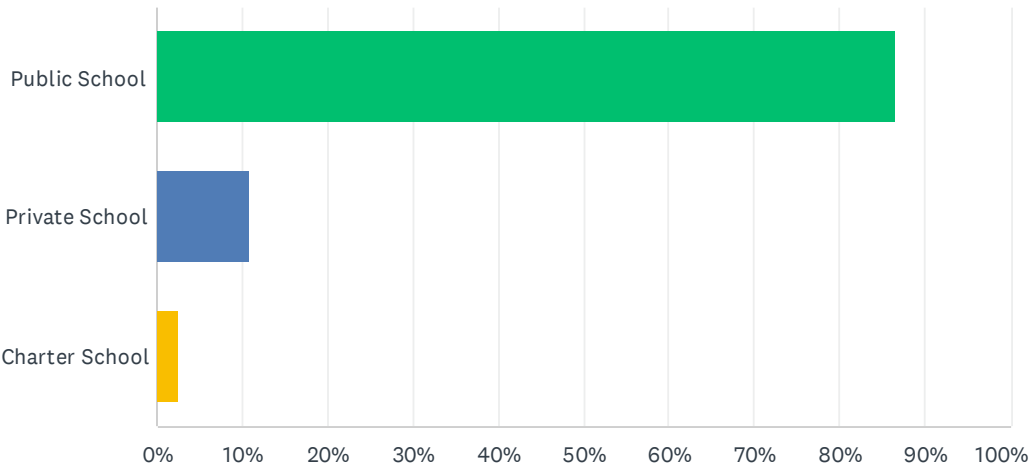

The day we did have an issue, I was the one who had to read and figure out what to do. It was minor and quickly fixed, but what if it wasn't? I do not know tech. They were literally only there to provide wifi and help if the wifi malfunctioned. They cannot help if Bluebook goes down. They cannot help if TDTK does not work. They cannot help if an entire exam malfunctions. I am SO thankful we did not have AP Psych. Who is the tech coordinator for those issues? It seems the ONLY solution is to provide late or exception testing.
